DUAL BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN AN APPROVED COLUMBIAN COLLEGE PROGRAM AND MASTER OF SCIENCE IN THE FIELD OF DATA SCIENCE

The Columbian College of Arts and Sciences and the Data Science Program work in coordination to offer a dual bachelor of science in an approved Columbian College major (http://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/#majorstext) and master of science in the field of data science (http://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/data-science/ms/) degree program. This dual program allows students the opportunity to study fundamental ideas that underlie the process of using data and problem solving and to apply the knowledge they gain to real-world scenarios. This is accomplished through elective coursework and partnerships with organizations in a variety of market areas, including health sciences, geography, cybersecurity, and public policy, to name a few. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.

Credit sharing:

Students can count up to 6 graduate credits as part of their undergraduate program.
