

DUAL BACHELOR OF ARTS WITH A MAJOR IN JOURNALISM AND MASS COMMUNICATION AND MASTER OF ARTS IN THE FIELD OF MEDIA AND STRATEGIC COMMUNICATION

The School of Media and Public Affairs in the Columbian College of Arts and Sciences offers a dual bachelor of arts with a major in journalism and mass communication (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/media-public-affairs/ba-journalism-mass-communication/>) and master of arts in the field of media and strategic communication (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/media-public-affairs/media-strategic-communication/>) degree. The program allows students to take 9 graduate credits as part of their undergraduate program, thereby decreasing the number of credits normally required for the master's degree. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.
