

DUAL MASTER OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION AND GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN NONPROFIT MANAGEMENT

The Trachtenberg School in Columbian College of Arts and Sciences offers a dual master of public administration (MPA) (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/public-policy-administration/mpa/>) and graduate certificate in nonprofit management (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/public-policy-administration/certificate-nonprofit-management/>) program. The 12 credits required for the certificate may be shared with the MPA by using them as field and/or elective courses. This allows students to earn both credentials in a shorter amount of time and at a lower cost than if pursued separately. All requirements for both programs must be fulfilled.
