

# DUAL MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AND MASTER OF SCIENCE IN THE FIELD OF TOURISM, HOSPITALITY, AND EVENT MANAGEMENT

The School of Business offers a dual master of business administration (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/business/mba/#text>) (MBA) and master of science in tourism, hospitality, and event management (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/business/management/mthem-tourism-hospitality-event-management/>) (MS) degree program. Up to 18 credits may be shared between programs. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.
