

DUAL BS IN INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS AND MS IN INFORMATION SYSTEMS TECHNOLOGY

The Elliott School for International Affairs (ESIA) and GW School of Business (GWSB) offer a dual bachelor of science in international affairs (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/international-affairs/undergraduate-programs/bs-international-affairs/>) and master of science in information systems (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/business/information-systems-technology-management/ms/>) degree program. The combined program allows students to take 9 graduate credits as part of their undergraduate program, thereby decreasing the number of credits normally required for the master's degree. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.
