

JOINT MAED&HD IN HIGHER EDUCATION ADMINISTRATION AND JURIS DOCTOR

The Graduate School of Education and Human Development (GSEHD) in cooperation with the Law School offers a joint master of education and human development (MAEd&HD) in the field of higher education administration (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/education-human-development/educational-leadership/master-higher-education-administration/>) and juris doctor (JD) (<https://www.law.gwu.edu/juris-doctor/>) degree program. Students must be admitted separately to each program and must fulfill all requirements for each degree. GSEHD accepts up to 6 credits of law courses toward requirements for the MAEd&HD and the Law School accepts up to 12 credits in GSEHD courses towards requirements for the JD. The degrees are conferred simultaneously once all requirements have been met.
