The master of international policy and practice-online (MIPP-Online) is an advanced degree for mid-career professionals seeking to advance in their current career track or transition to a new field. An accelerated 27-credit distance learning program, it allows civilian and military professionals working around the world to complete a master's degree within one year of full-time study, or 16 to 24 months of part-time study. The MIPP-Online prepares graduates to harness an exceptional understanding of the complex international policy environment, possess robust analytical and communication skills, and master skills for coalition building and leading organizational change.
