

# DUAL BSHS IN MOLECULAR DIAGNOSTIC SCIENCES AND MSHS IN CLINICAL MICROBIOLOGY

The School of Medicine and Health Sciences offers a dual bachelor of science in health sciences with a major in molecular diagnostic sciences (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/medicine-health-sciences/undergraduate-programs/bshs-molecular-diagnostic-sciences/>) and master of science in health sciences in the field of clinical microbiology (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/medicine-health-sciences/graduate-programs/ms-clinical-microbiology/>) degree program. The program allows students to take 9 graduate credits as part of their undergraduate program, thereby decreasing the number of credits normally required for the master's degree. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.
