DUAL MASTER OF ARTS IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND SUSTAINABILITY POLICY AND GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN REGULATORY POLICY AND PRACTICE

The Trachtenberg School of Public Policy and Public Administration offers a dual master of arts in the field of environmental and sustainability policy (https://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/public-policy-administration/esp-ma/) and graduate certificate in regulatory policy and practice (https://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/public-policy-administration/certificate-regulatory-policy-practice/) program. The 12 credits in courses required for the certificate can be counted toward the MPP. This allows students to earn both credentials in a shorter period of time and at a lower cost than if pursued separately. All requirements for both programs must be fulfilled.
