

DUAL BACHELOR OF PROFESSIONAL STUDIES WITH A MAJOR IN CYBERSECURITY AND MASTER OF PROFESSIONAL STUDIES IN THE FIELD OF CYBERSECURITY STRATEGY AND INFORMATION MANAGEMENT

The College of Professional Studies offers a dual bachelor of professional studies (BPS) with a major in cybersecurity (<https://bulletin.gwu.edu/professional-studies/bps-cybersecurity/>) and master of professional studies (MPS) in the field of cybersecurity strategy and information management (<https://bulletin.gwu.edu/professional-studies/mps-cybersecurity-strategy-information-management/>) program. The program allows for the double counting of 6 credits earned in courses completed in the BPS program toward completion of the MPS degree. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.

Interested students should confer with their academic advisor in the fall semester of their senior year. Applications to the dual degree program are due in early December of the senior year.
