

DUAL BACHELOR OF SCIENCE WITH A MAJOR IN EXERCISE SCIENCE AND MASTER OF SCIENCE IN THE FIELD OF EXERCISE SCIENCE

The Milken Institute School of Public Health offers a dual bachelor of science with a major in exercise science (<https://bulletin.gwu.edu/public-health/exercise-science/bs/>) (BS) and master of science in the field of exercise science (<https://bulletin.gwu.edu/public-health/exercise-science/ms-exercise-science/>) (MS) degree program. The program allows students to take up to 9 graduate credits as part of their undergraduate degree, thereby decreasing the number of credits normally required for the master's degree. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.
