BA in Korean Language and Literature	Removed deactivated KOR 4122W as an alternative to KOR 4121W in the required curriculum, as KOR 4122W is no longer being offered.	Fall 2025
BS in Biomedical Engineering	A number of curriculum corrections were made to semesters 5 through 8. This action was taken to correct errors in the Bulletin putting it out of sync with SEAS advising materials.	Fall 2025
School of Nursing Regulations	Updated language (but not meaning) of section "Appeal Procedures for Cases of Alleged Improper Academic Evaluation" to "Appeal Process for Cases of Alleged Arbitrary or Capricious Academic Evaluation"	Fall 2025
Dual BPS in Cybersecurity and MPS in Cybersecurity Strategy and Information Management	Replaced PSCS 3103 with PSCS 3103W under Shared Credits as the former was deactivated and replaced by the latter.	Fall 2025
Graduate Certificate in Islamic Studies	Removed from current (2025-2026) Bulletin as it has been inactive for a number of years.	Fall 2025
Post-baccalaureate Certificate in Clinical Embryology and Assisted Reproductive Technology	Changed total number of required credits from 20 to 21. This is a correction, not a change to the program requirements, as the required curriculum already added up to 21 credits.	Fall 2025
Master of Arts in Speech-Language Pathology	Students pursuing the thesis option take 4 credits in thesis coursework, not 6 as was originally published. This is a correction, not a change in degree requirements.	Fall 2025
Master of Arts in Security Policy Studies	Removal of Optional Thesis from the curriculum. This change is already in effect within ESIA as of fall 2025, but it was inadvertently left in the current Bulletin.	Fall 2025
