

DUAL BACHELOR OF ARTS WITH A MAJOR IN PHILOSOPHY (PUBLIC AFFAIRS FOCUS) AND MASTER OF ARTS IN THE FIELD OF PUBLIC POLICY WITH A CONCENTRATION IN PHILOSOPHY AND SOCIAL POLICY

The Department of Philosophy and the Trachtenberg School of Public Policy and Public Administration work in cooperation to offer a dual bachelor of arts with a major in philosophy (public affairs focus) (<https://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/philosophy/ba-public-affairs/>) and master of arts in the field of public policy with a concentration in philosophy and social justice (<https://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/philosophy/ma-public-policy/>) degree program. The program allows students to take 9 graduate credits as part of their undergraduate program, thereby decreasing the number of credits normally required for the master's degree. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.
