

DUAL BACHELOR OF ARTS WITH A MAJOR IN PSYCHOLOGICAL AND BRAIN SCIENCES AND MASTER OF ARTS IN THE FIELD OF ART THERAPY

The Department of Psychological and Brain Sciences offers a combined bachelor of arts with a major in psychological and brain sciences (<https://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/psychological-and-brain-sciences/ba/>) and a master of arts in the field of art therapy (<https://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/art-therapy/ma/>) program. The program allows students to take a specified number of graduate credits as part of their undergraduate program, thereby decreasing the number of credits normally required for the master's degree. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.
