

DUAL MASTER OF PUBLIC POLICY AND GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN BUDGET AND PUBLIC FINANCE

The Trachtenberg School of Public Policy and Public Administration offers a dual master of public policy (<https://mail.google.com/mail/u/0/bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/public-policy-administration/mpp/>) (MPP) and graduate certificate in budget and public finance (<https://mail.google.com/mail/u/0/bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/public-policy-administration/certificate-budget-public-finance/>) program. The 12 credits in courses required for the certificate can be counted toward the MPP by using them as MPP field and/or elective courses. This allows students to earn both credentials in a shorter amount of time and at a lower cost than if pursued separately. All requirements for both programs must be fulfilled.
