The GW School of Business offers a dual master of business administration (<https://bulletin.gwu.edu/business/mba/>) (MBA) and master of science in the field of information systems technology (<https://bulletin.gwu.edu/business/information-systems-technology-management/ms/>) (MSIST) degree program. Up to 21 credits of coursework may be shared between programs: 12 credits of ISTM graduate courses may be applied toward the MBA, and 9 credits of ISTM-designated STEM electives in the MBA may be applied toward the MS.
