

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN CLINICAL LABORATORY MANAGEMENT

The graduate certificate in clinical laboratory management (CLM) program prepares working clinical laboratory professionals to sit for the American Society for Clinical Pathology (ASCP) Diplomate in Laboratory Management (DLM) certification examination.

The CLM program emphasizes the following content areas:

- Operations management
- Human resource management
- Quality systems management
- Financial management applied to the operation of a modern laboratory

Additional areas include leading a diverse and inclusive workforce, workforce education and training, and data analytics and research methods.

Professional opportunities for program graduates include supervisory roles in hospitals, in public health, and in reference laboratories, biotechnology industries, and governmental and educational institutions.
