Your essay should also speak to the role (e.g. FNP, AGACNP, etc.) that you are applying for and how your qualifications will help you succeed in this role both professionally and as a student.

Additional:	Active RN license Preferred scholastic GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale from a regionally accredited college or university Current CPR certificate
