

REGISTERED NURSE TO BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING

The online registered nurse (RN) to bachelor of science in nursing (BSN) degree program is available to students with an associate's degree who are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination—Registered Nurse (NCLEX-RN). Students enter the program with up to 84 credits in advanced standing, allowing them to progress quickly through the BSN program while continuing to work as professional nurses. Students must become licensed as a registered nurse within the first semester of matriculation in the program.
